EUROCHAMBRES calls for stepping up efforts to improve the business climate in the Eastern Partnership region

On the eve of the 5th Eastern Partnership (EaP) summit in Brussels, EUROCHAMBRES calls for a strong political engagement of the European Union to the EaP countries and underlines the importance of further economic reforms, development of the private sector and independent business support organisations for increasing the trade and investment opportunities with EU businesses.

EUROCHAMBRES urges the EU leaders to enhance its support for the involvement of the EaP private sector in the reform efforts for improving the business environment for the SMEs, thus contributing to the success of the transition process in the 6 EaP countries.
