## EUROCHAMBRES launches programme to strengthen Egyptian business organisations

EUROCHAMBRES, the Association of European Chambers of Commerce and Industry, has signed a contract in the framework of the EU-Egyptian Industrial Modernisation Programme (IMP). It aims at supporting Egyptian business organisations and developing sustainable links with their European counterparts.

EUROCHAMBRES will organise over the next 2 years capacity building sessions for Egyptian business organisations and support a range of twinning agreements between European and Egyptian Chambers, with focus on internationalisation services for SMEs. The contract will operate with a  $\leq 1.65$  mn budget.

EUROCHAMBRES' Secretary General Arnaldo Abruzzini said: "The EU-Association Agreement with Egypt, which has now been ratified by all 15 Member states, will generate increased opportunities for European businesses to enter this strategic location; Egypt is a gateway to the Arab and African markets. Through EUROCHAMBRES' activities, the European Chamber network will be able to build up privileged links with Egyptian counterparts, to the benefit of business."

The Egyptian Minister of Industry and Technological Development Dr. El Saeidi. expressed confidence in the European Chamber network to support their Egyptian counterparts, to the benefit of EU-Egyptian relations.

The EU is Egypt's largest trading partner, accounting for over 30% of its exports and imports. Traditionally, Egypt has been a major beneficiary of EU financial co-operation in the framework of its Mediterranean policy. The IMP programme is co-funded by the Egyptian government and the European Union MEDA programme.
