

The Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Serbia and the Chamber of Commerce of Kosovo meet ahead of European Council

Under the auspices of EUROCHAMBRES' Secretary General Arnaldo Abruzzini and the European Commission's DG Enlargement Director of Enlargement Policy and Strategy Pierre Mirel, a meeting between the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Serbia and the Chamber of Commerce of Kosovo took place in Brussels.

This meeting is the first concrete action organised by these Chambers following the Agreement signed on 19 April between the two respective Prime Ministers.

Both Chambers were represented by their Presidents, respectively Zeljko Sertic, President of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Serbia, and Safet Gerxhaliu, President of the Chamber of Commerce of Kosovo.

Both parties have agreed that this meeting is an important step in the direction of improving the business environment in the region. The meeting was dedicated to the establishment of a process of official communication and further cooperation.

The Presidents of both Chambers agreed to continue the dialogue and to meet again with concrete activities of mutual interest for both Chambers and their member companies.
