

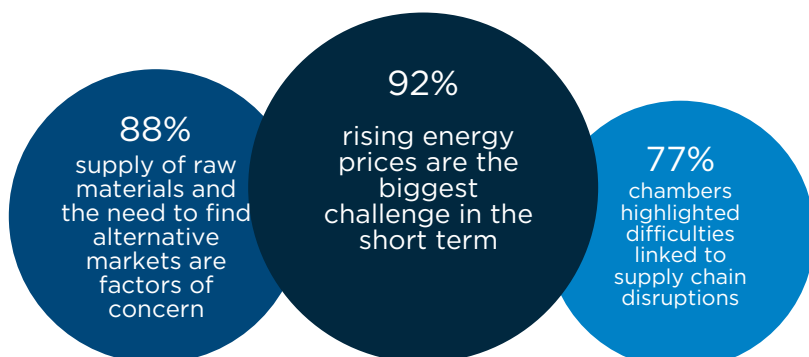
Eurochambres flash survey on the economic impact of the war in Ukraine

Eurochambres flash survey on the impact of the war in Ukraine was conducted late March 2022 among Eurochambres' members with the aim of understanding the implications of the war in Ukraine across Europe. The survey happened one month after the Russian invasion of Ukraine and after several rounds of sanctions adopted by the EU. For this exercise, 26 national chambers provided feedback on the economic implications of the war.
